DRIVER'S EDUCATION for 2014-2015

1st session – **September 2nd to October 31st**. Students must be 14 ½ by September 26th.



2nd session – **February 2nd to March 31st.** Students must be 14 ½ by February 23rd.

3rd session – **June 1st to June 31st.** Students must be 14 ½ by June 12th.

The first 2 sessions may be taken by any student in grades 9-12. The last session, (June) is for students in grades 8-12. This includes home-schooled students.

The cost is \$175.00. Please make a check out to Huntley Project High School and turn it in to Marlene Krum in the Central Office between August 20th and August 30th for the first session. The application for Driver's Education can be printed off from the Huntley Project website under the Driver's Ed icon. You may also pick up a paper application from me if you would like. - The top part on the front under the Questionnaire for Athletic Participation
- Fill in the name and date of birth on page two
- Fill out the Parent's or Guardian's permission and release at the bottom of page two. This includes the insurance information. The parent must sign in this location.

Lockwood Chiropractic Health Center will be giving free sport physicals in the Training Room in the high school. These physicals will be offered on June 7th from 8:30 AM-12:00 PM. They do meet MHSA standards and will be offered again for free. The students need to sign up for a time slot for their physical in the HS office. If you miss your time slot, you will be moved to the end of the day.

RiverStone Health Clinic in Worden will provide Sport Physicals at the clinic this summer. The date will be in July and is traditionally the week of July 21st.. Please contact RiverStone Health Worden Clinic, and they will have more information in early June. Appointments are not necessary, but if a specific time is needed, then an appointment should be made. The physicals will be payable on the date of the physical. For questions or appointments, please call the RiverStone Clinic in Worden at 967-2255.

The sport physical form is available at the school or at the clinic. Parents **NEED** to sign the back of the form if they are not accompanying their student to the clinic.

IMMUNIZATION POLICY

All students must meet State Immunization requirements prior to attending school. If your child is new to the district or entering kindergarten or 7th grade, then please check with your healthcare provider or with the school nurse to make sure that your child has been adequately immunized. Hola from the Spanish Department



We are wrapping things up for the end of the year in our Spanish classes. The 4th quarter 8th graders will be getting a cultural perspective on the Day of the Dead (Día de los Muertos), which really occurs on November 1st and 2nd. It is a celebration in which families honor the memory and life of loved ones who have passed away. They will get to decorate sugar skulls and cut designs on tissue paper called Papel Picado.

The high school Spanish classes will get to celebrate "Cinco de Mayo" with a fiesta. They will get to make and try different Hispanic recipes throughout the Spanish-speaking world—some of those recipes include Migas which is similar to stuffing but has garlic and chorizo sausage, Empanadas de pino al horno—a meat pie with onions and spices, and Brazo de Reina—a Chilean dessert that is made of a sponge cake and manjar or dulce de leche (caramelized sweetened condensed milk).

We are looking forward to our Spanish Club— Perú Crew trip next school vear. They will get to use their Spanish skills and tour Lima, Peru's capital city, Cuzco an Incan city, the ruins of Machu Picchu, the Amazon Rainforest, as well as participate in other adventurous activities. The students in that club have been raising money through various fundraisers and are planning a fundraiser at the Pizza Ranch on May 28th! We would love to see members of the community come out for some dining at the Pizza Ranch in support of our crew that evening from 4pm to 8pm. The kids will be bussing tables and anyone eating that comes and eats at the Pizza Ranch or orders takeout/delivery will help us to earn 20% of the profits.
